

Mobile Applications You Might Need!



DB Navigator

Deutsche Bahn is a German railway company and it is one of the largest transport companies in the world. When you travel all around Germany, DB is a great option! Also you will be able to use DB trains free (except ICE, IC trains) within the North-Rhine Westphalia area.

This app might be very useful for you! After choosing a starting point and a destination you will receive itinerary information (platform number, train number, departure time, possible delays). It also shows the buses and trams around your city.

MyUDE

MyUDE app offers up-to-date information about UDE! You can access your semester ticket with this app and you can see the departure times of the UDE shuttle bus service and public transportation, as well as possible delays of buses and trains.

This app also provides information of the weekly overview of all dishes in all refectories at the UDE. Moreover, you can find your timetable and all student councils are represented there, the links to the LSF, enrollments, counseling, examination offices, scholarships etc. can be found as well.



VRR App

VRR is the public transport association covering the area of the Rhine-Ruhr conurbation in Germany. The VRR area consists of Essen, Mülheim, Bochum, Dortmund, Duisburg, Oberhausen, Düsseldorf, Mönchengladbach, Solingen, Wuppertal etc. If you want to travel within these cities you can either use the DB Navigator or VRR app.

After downloading this app and completing the registration you can easily rent a bike! You will be able to see the bike stations and rent a bike by scanning the QR Code with this app. The bike stations are called "metropolraduhr" and can be easily spotted due to their orange color. One hour is free for all students!
