Visa	The International Office will coordinate the visa applications with the Immigration Department on behalf of the incoming exchange students. Incoming exchange students should follow the CHECKLIST carefully to prepare and submit all required documents before the deadline.	
	Visa applications are reviewed by the Immigration Department individually and take <u>at least 6-8 weeks to process after application deadline</u> , provided that there are no questions on the applications. Please expect the result to be announced by:

Insurance	All incoming exchange students are required to obtain adequate insurance before arriving in Hong Kong. Students may enroll in HKBU's plan or independent plan. Please refer to HERE for more information.
