### **Nomination Process**



### Email the nomination to <u>Study@usc.edu.au</u>

Please include student's:

full name, email address, current level of study, UniSC intake and program.

- For the double degree program: please include their current program name.
- For exchange students: please nominate them to global@usc.edu.au

Once nomination received, we will contact your students and provide them with the steps on how to submit their application on our online portal but also useful information about life and studies on the Sunshine Coast (such as accommodation).

### Recommended deadlines (flexible):

- Trimester 1 / Session 2 (March intake): 30 November
- Trimester 2 / Session 6 intake (July / August intake): 30 April

### **Application Process: How to Apply**



#### Step 1:

Register an account and complete application online via the International Student Portal.



### Step 2:

Complete the online application form and attach supporting documents (identification and academic transcripts).



### Step 3:

Finalise and submit application. Application status can be checked via the International Application Portal.



Recommended deadline (flexible):

- Trimester 1 / Session 2 (March intake): 30 November
- Trimester 2 / Session 6 intake (July / August intake): 30 April





### Steps to apply

A quick guide: submitting an application to UniSC



#### Explore

your program options and contact your home university for further advice about eligibility requirements.



### 2 Register

an online account with the international application portal.

We suggest using an email address you frequently check and taking note of the password you use to register. You can edit and save your application as often as you like before submitting it to UniSC. After submitting, you can check the status of your application at any time using



the log in details you provide when

you register.

### 3 Apply

online via the international application portal. Choose your UniSC program and upload supporting documents to submit your application.

Be sure to have your passport image page, academic transcripts and evidence of English proficiency ready to upload.



#### Respond

to your offer by reviewing your offer letter details in the international application portal.



Once you have accepted your offer, UniSC issues important documents and updates including Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) used for a Student visa and UniSC login details.



#### **4** Application assessment

is completed by the UniSC Admissions team and an offer is made accordingly.

You will be notified via email regarding the outcome of your application. You can also check the status of your application at any time via the portal.



#### **6** Prepare

for your studies abroad and apply for your visa, organise travel and accommodation arrangements and prepare for your departure.


