- For the double degree program: please include their current program name.
- For exchange students: please nominate them to global@usc.edu.au

Once nomination received, we will contact your students and provide them with the steps on how to submit their application on our online portal but also useful information about life and studies on the Sunshine Coast (such as accommodation).

Recommended deadlines (flexible):

- Trimester 1 / Session 2 (March intake): 30 November
- Trimester 2 / Session 6 intake (July / August intake): 30 April

Application Process: How to Apply



Step 1:

Register an account and complete application online via the **International Student Portal**.



Step 2:

Complete the online application form and attach supporting documents (identification and academic transcripts).



Step 3:

Finalise and submit application. Application status can be checked via the **International Application Portal**.

- Trimester 2 / Session 6 intake (July / August intake): 30 April



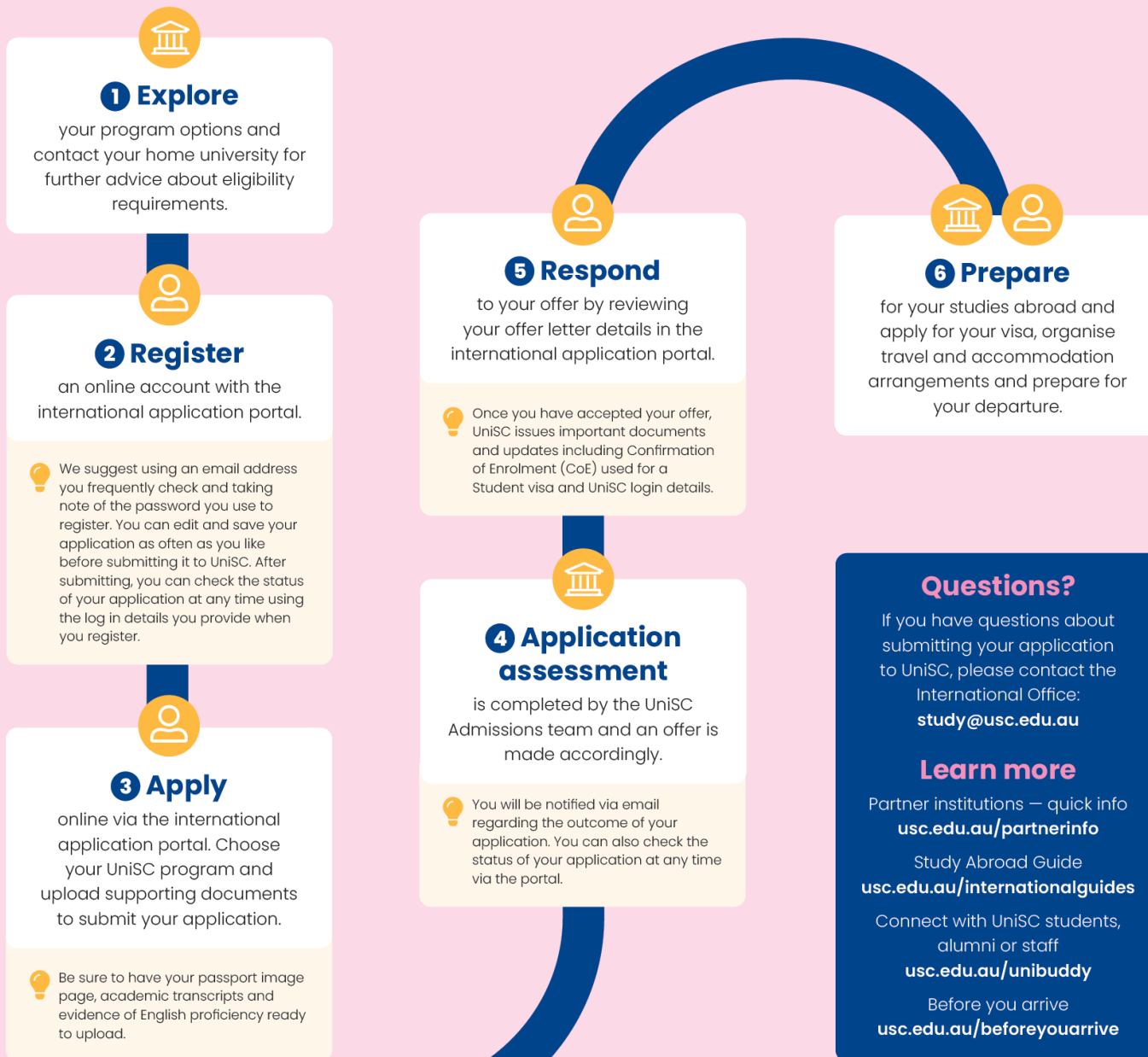

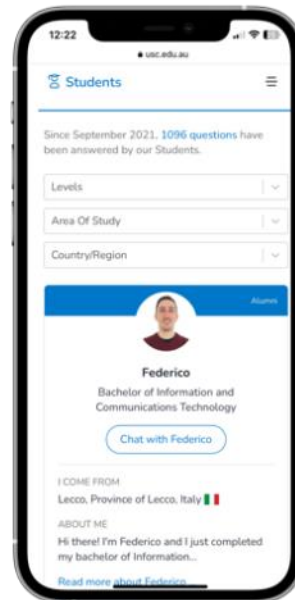
