History and general information	Founded in 1635, ELTE is a modern research university with nearly 400-year-old traditions. ELTE is the largest academic establishment in Hungary, and it is also the country's most popular and internationally highest-ranking university. It has the widest educational portfolio in the country with 9 faculties teaching over 170 bachelor's and master's, as well as close to 140 doctoral programmes, including around 140 degree programmes in foreign languages. ELTE's campuses are located on both sides of the river Danube in Budapest, as well as in Nyíregyháza and Szombathely.

Programmes	ELTE GTK offers 4 Bachelor programmes including 2 that are also accredited as English-only first-degree programmes for Hungarian and international students. The Faculty currently has approximately 3,000 first-degree students. The Faculty also offers 6 Hungarian Master's programmes, full-time or part-time, including a two-year Master of Business Administration (MBA) programme. Presently, over 2,000 postgraduate and 250 MBA students study at ELTE GTK. Since 2021, the Faculty has also offered a PhD programme in Hungarian at the Doctoral School of Business and Management .
