TUITION PER SEMESTER

- \$ 17,178.00 International students attending schools outside the US
- \$ 22,904.00 Domestic and international students attending schools in the US
(prevailing American University tuition rate)

ESTIMATED HEALTH INSURANCE

\$ 780.00	AU Health Insurance - Fall only Must be waived prior to September 16, 2017 to avoid fee
\$ 1,750.00	AU Health Insurance - Full year August 1, 2017 – July 31, 2018 for students who enroll

Health insurance is required for registration at AU; students with private insurance may opt out to avoid charges. Students should waive health insurance prior to the start of the semester to avoid or have the charge removed. Final waiver deadline is September 16, 2017. Fall 2017 health insurance is effective August 1 through December 18, 2017 for students who opt to enroll in the plan. The plan will be effective for students who are auto-enrolled and do not waive the insurance starting on September 24, 2017. Prices quoted are from AY 2016-17. Health Insurance costs for AY 2017-18 will be available in late April 2017.
