



- Full transfer credit back to home university


Admission Requirements

- Minimum TOEFL score of 550
PBT, iBT 80, TOEIC 690, IELTS 6.5 or equivalent
- Home university recommendation preferred
- Minimum age: 17
- F-1 visa



Students may request an official UCR Extension transcript (includes grades and numbers of credits transferrable to the student's home institution).




